The Center for Independent Living of North Central Florida (CILNCF), the main office located in Gainesville, Florida, seeks a highly qualified, collaborative, engaged, and consumer focused leader to serve as its next Executive Director. The mission of the CILNCF is to empower people with disabilities to achieve their goals for independence

Reporting to Board of Directors, the ED position is an onsite, office-based position that serves as the chief executive officer of the organization and has direct administrative responsibility for the effective and efficient running of the agency. The position supervises seven direct reports that make up the leadership team, and oversees a \$2.5 million budget that includes federal, state, city, municipal service, and auxiliary funding sources.

A Master's degree, or Bachelor's degree with a minimum of five years, in Rehabilitation, Counseling, Psychology, Sociology, Social Work, or other related field, two years of experience in human social services, five years of supervisory experience, a deep understanding of the independent living philosophy and movement, knowledge of disability civil rights, and knowledge and awareness of community resources and larger systems serving people with disabilities are required.

Interested applicants must submit a letter of intent, a current resume/curriculum vitae, list of three professional references, and an unofficial academic transcript. Unofficial transcripts are only accepted for review purposes, official transcripts are required prior to any offer of employment being made.
